Year 6 Residential Trip – 23rd March – 25th March 2027
Thorpe Woodlands Adventure Centre

The school has arranged a three-day activity programme staying in Escape Pods at Thorpe Woodlands from Tuesday 23rd to Thursday 25th March next year. This will be an exciting opportunity for the children to explore a range of challenging activities outside of school. The main emphasis of the trip is to develop resilience, leadership skills and team building.

Thorpe Woodlands is a purpose-built centre that hosts schools from all over the country all year round. They team of dedicated and highly trained staff are there to lead activities and encourage the children to take on the different challenges. The centre is in the forest away from the public. There will be one other school staying at the centre when we arrive, but they will be staying in a different building. The forest is an exceptionally quiet and tranquil place to be.

Included in the trip:

- All of the adventurous activities run by the Thorpe Woodlands Team.
- Accommodation for 2 nights.
- All meals and refreshments for 3 days, including special dietary requirements.
- Use of the centre facilities for 'down time'.

This is a wonderful opportunity for the children to be able to take part in a variety of activities that they wouldn't get to experience in school. I know that the Year 5 children were particularly excited to see Year 6's class assembly where they shared their experience.
