South America – Lavenham

In the summer term, South America will be learning about the history of the wool industry in Suffolk, focussing on its development in Lavenham. Therefore, we would like to visit Lavenham on Thursday 23rd May and experience both the Guildhall and the Church of St Peter and St Paul which were significant during this time. The cost for the trip will be £6.20.

The children will need to be in school for the usual time of 8.35am and they will be returning to school for the usual collection time of 3.15pm. They will need to be in their school uniform and be prepared for the day's weather as we will be walking around Lavenham during the visit too.
