Year 4 Daws Hall Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June

As part of our science topic this term, Europe class are learning about “Living Things and Their Habitats.” To support our learning, I have arranged for the whole class to visit Daws Hall on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June**.

Located in Lamarsh, Essex, Daws Hall is a nature reserve and will provide the children with various opportunities to work scientifically outside of the classroom. Activities will include pond dipping, learning about invertebrates and studying in detail the local flora and fauna.

Daws Hall is predominantly an outdoor venue and, whilst there is some shelter for lunch and a small classroom, we will be outdoors all day and appropriate clothing is vital. This includes sturdy, sensible footwear such as trainers or wellies, a waterproof jacket in the event of rain, sun cream and a sun hat. Please also ensure that your child does not have bare legs as we may be working in long grass. Otherwise, your child should come to school in normal school uniform.

We will be travelling by coach and will depart school promptly at 9am. We are being collected by coach at 2.30pm and will be back at school by 3pm. Please collect your child from school at the usual time.

A contribution of £7.50 per child can be paid on Arbor or via the office. All children require a packed lunch and a water bottle. Please use the slip below to order a packed lunch from the kitchen.
