Cedars – IWM Duxford

As part of our history topic in the Summer term, World War 2: The Battle of Britain (focussing on its impact in Suffolk and East Anglia), Cedars will be visiting the Imperial War Museum: Duxford on Thursday 26th May 2022.

This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to see and experience aircraft that children during WW2 might have spotted flying overhead, including the Spitfire, Lancaster and Tiger Moth. We will be visiting their 'Battle of Britain' exhibition to follow actual stories from RAF personnel and learn about the pivotal role Duxford, and the rest of East Anglia, played in this too.

The visit to IWM: Duxford is free for the children, however there is a cost of £14 for the coach. This will be available to pay on Arbor.

The children can be dropped off at school at the normal time of 8.40am and we will be leaving promptly at 9am to allow for traffic. We will be returning to school slightly later than the normal school day at approx. 4.30pm.

The children will need to be in their school uniform and must bring a packed lunch, drink and appropriate outerwear, as some exhibitions are outside. If your child receives free school meals, you can order a lunch on the reply slip below.
