Cedars – Sutton Hoo

As part of our history topic of Anglo-Saxons this term, Cedars will be visiting Sutton Hoo on Thursday 21st October 2021.

This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to enjoy exploring a local history site, which is also part of our National Trust. During the day, we will be taking a guided tour around the burial ground where they will see and experience some genuine Anglo-Saxon artefacts, as well as participate in an archaeological activity.

The visit to Sutton Hoo is free for the children, as the school is a member of the National Trust, however we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £10.50 per child for the cost of the coach. This will be available to pay on Arbor. If your child is entitled to free school meals and you are in need of financial support for this trip please email the office.

The children can be dropped off at school at the normal time of 8.40am and we will be leaving promptly at 9.00am to allow for traffic. We will be **returning to school slightly later** than the normal school day at approx. **4.30pm**.

The children will need to be in their school uniform and all children must bring a packed lunch, drink and appropriate outerwear, as some exhibitions are outside.
